Product Inspection Before Production

In a Product Inspection Before Production, goods are inspected after the production of the first 10 units. The specific goods that will be inspected are taken from the first unit produced, according to the GSP sampling method. The quantity of samples will be pre-determined by the GSP staff in the inspection request form.

- Make sure your goods are manufactured according to our standards
- Prevent initial non-conformity due to misunderstanding with your supplier
- Reduce new product launch lead time (as well as Express Courier Fees and other related costs)

Product Inspection During Production

A Product Inspection During Production takes place during the actual production process. The goods are selected at random according to the GSP sampling method and at a quantity fixed by the GSP staff when they fill out the quotation form.

During this inspection, all the specifications and tests will be evaluated according to GSP requirements. The product inspection during production allows you to check the production on-site once all processes have been started. It will guarantee a high quality level during all the production.

- Obtain the guarantee that the products specifications are meet
- Verify the accuracy of some production key process that can't be evaluate when production is 100% completed.

Product Inspection Before Shipment

In a Product Inspection Before Shipment, goods are inspected after the full production and when most of the items are packed and ready for shipment. The goods that will be inspected are selected randomly from the entire production according to the GSP sampling method, with the number of samples fixed by the GSP order form.

During this inspection, all the specifications and tests will be evaluated. This inspection before shipment gives you confidence that all of the production is in accordance with your technical requirements, and that the goods that will be shipped are in good condition.

- Reduce any risk of goods shipped to your clients or your warehouse
- Make sure your products respect your drawings and specifications.
- Knowing that your products will be shipped in good conditions with the right packaging.
